Collected Over \$77,000 in Pledge Money – First project – Cement and Installation of Bricks!

I would like to update on the Parish Transformation and TTWCI campaign at this time. I am very happy to report that both of these programs are quite successful as we since started them last year at this time. Results from the Parish Transformation Program survey indicated the need for some additional programs here at our parish, of which two have already been formed. These include a Dementia Support Group and a Welcoming Committee. I know both of these programs will be beneficial to many of our parishioners, and I invite you to contact the Pastoral Center or view our website for additional information about them.

In addition, we experienced overwhelming success for the TTWCI Campaign. We exceeded our goal set by the Archdiocese and have currently collected over \$77,000 in pledge money and are preparing to begin our first project: the installation of new concrete, as well as memorial bricks, at both entrances to the church. A handicapped-accessible ramp will be installed at the Wellington entrance to the church as well. Donors who have already contributed a minimum of \$1000 will receive a complimentary memorial brick at this time. Information about this campaign is also available on our website.
